When I first met you, Tom, you were giving a talk on Catholicism. on a Sunday. I attended the class to obtain information that would help me to get through to my parents, who are VERY Catholic (my Mom was in the

convent but then decided to marry my Dad!). From that class, I heard about "Seed Sowers", and now I am starting to make small but important inroads with my folks. And others.
